CHAPTER RESPONSIBILITIES

The **Naomi Rabb Winston Scholarship in Two-Dimensional Art** was established to give talented young artists educational opportunities in preparation for careers in art.

Each brochure includes: applicant requirements and eligibility information, an application form, directions for judging, chapter and national deadlines, contact information for each NSAL chapter and a list of art institutions where applicants may choose to study.

The brochures can be printed from the **NSAL website arts-nsal.org**.

Participating NSAL Chapters should:

- 1. Distribute scholarship information** to colleges, universities, high schools and private teachers. Publicize the availability of the scholarship through local media and social networks.
- 2. Receive application forms and accompanying materials** (CDs/flash drives and prints) **by February 1, 2017**. Check that the applications are complete and include proof of citizenship and age.
- 3. Select competent judges**. Chapter members and advisors with a specialty in art may serve as judges.
- 4. Submit the applications of one or two finalists** selected by the judges. **A \$15 check to NSAL-Winston must be included for 1 application, \$30 for 2 applications.**
- 5. Send applications to the National Winston Art Chair before the deadline of March 1, 2017**. Mail them to **Christina Cosdon, 2164 Sunset Circle, Largo, FL 33774**.
