CHAPTER RESPONSIBILITIES

The **Shirley Rabb Winston Scholarship in Classical Voice** was established to give talented young singers opportunities in preparation for careers in voice performance or education.

Each brochure includes: applicant requirements and eligibility information, an application form, directions for judging, chapter and national deadlines, contact information for each NSAL chapter and a list of art institutions where applicants may choose to study.

The brochures can be printed from the NSAL website arts-nsal.org.

Participating NSAL Chapters should:

- **1. Distribute scholarship information** to colleges, universities, high schools and private teachers. Publicize the availability of the scholarship through local media and social networks.
- 2. Receive application forms and YouTube auditions and addresses by February 1, 2017.

Check:

That the applications are complete and include proof of citizenship and age.

That the YouTube addresses are included.

Applications can be received by e-mail or by regular mail.

- 3. Select competent judges. Chapter members and advisors with a specialty in voice may serve as judges.
- 4. Submit the applications and YouTube auditions of one or two finalists selected by the judges. A \$15 check to NSAL-Winston must be included for 1 application, \$30 for 2 applications.
