The NSAL-SAIC Kathy Morgan Lee Scholarship is a merit-based fund that covers tuition, campus housing, travel, meals, supplies, and incidentals for one student enrolled in two Adult Continuing Education one-week summer intensives. To be eligible, applicants must be between the ages of 23 and 30.
